AVG Network Edition provides antivirus protection and management of workstations for large and small companies. It provides all of the AVG Anti-Virus advanced detection methods and components – including heuristic analysis, generic detection, scanning, and integrity checking – with the AVG Resident Shield, E-mail Scanner, and Virus Vault. And, it makes them available on all of the workstations and servers within your network. AVG Network Edition also includes an integrated desktop firewall to protect individual workstations against unauthorized access from internal and external networks.

AVG supports two user-friendly interfaces to provide the tools that are right for you. The Basic Interface emphasizes simple control of the application and offers an intuitive interface for full administrative functionality. The Advanced Interface is aimed at network administrators who require access to a large network of workstations, more comprehensive information, and detailed configuration overviews and reports.

ADDED SECURITY WITH AN INTEGRATED DESKTOP FIREWALL

Adding to the peace of mind that you get with AVG Anti-Virus is AVG Firewall – an integral part of AVG Network Edition. Safeguarding the workstation or laptop on which it is installed, AVG Firewall helps maintain privacy and protects personally identifiable information from being sent from the computer without the user's permission.

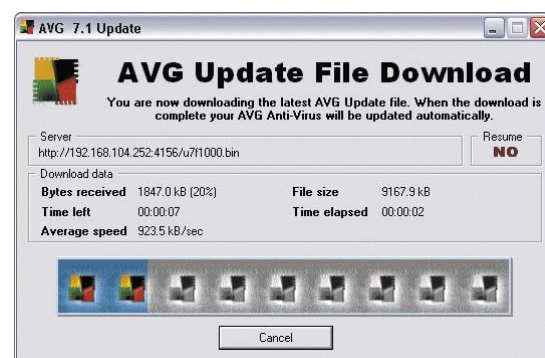
AVG Firewall protects against external threats by hiding the computer from hackers and detecting Potentially Unwanted Programs that try to collect data and send it back to their

creators. It also controls how a computer exchanges data with other computers on the Internet or a local network.

AVG Firewall controls traffic on network ports by assigning rules to the applications communicating over the network – allowing/blocking traffic accordingly or prompting you about what should be done in certain situations. AVG Firewall will also ask the user to permit or deny communication for any new application, then create a new application rule based on that decision. When no user is logged on, queries are automatically suppressed and actions blocked for maximum protection.

AVG NETWORK EDITION COMPONENTS

- AVG Anti-Virus plus Firewall – antivirus and firewall protection for all of your network workstations
- AVG File Server Edition – extends protection to Windows NT4/2000/2003 or Linux servers
- AVGADMIN – centrally administers and manage all workstations on the network (see below for more information)
- AVG S-Tool – easily installs AVG on all workstations remotely

MANAGEMENT WITH AVGADMIN

AVGADMIN provides the tools to centrally install and configure AVG clients anywhere in the network, and manage updates from a local Web server or network directory. AVGADMIN is independent of the network (Microsoft, Novell, P2P, etc.) and server architecture, ensuring convenient administration in networks of any size. The tools support remote management of all clients in the local network — allowing the administrator to run tests, trigger virus and program updates, modify settings, and process data.

Central administration utilizes the DataCenter, which serves as the communication mechanism for updating client settings, test definitions and other system commands, virus alerts, and other information. The DataCenter can be configured to operate using a TCP server (recommended for most configurations) or other SQL servers.

In an industry first, AVG Anti-Virus release 7.1 also offers optional AVG Managed Updates, in which Grisoft will proactively deliver antivirus updates as they are created. Available with AVG Network Edition for an additional fee, AVG Managed Updates alerts you as soon as an update is available and initiates the download to your TCP server.

Going a step beyond the already high levels of protection provided by scheduled and manual updates, AVG Managed Updates offers maximum convenience by putting Grisoft in charge of your virus updates. Grisoft will even notify you if your server has not accepted an update, to help make sure you always have up-to-the-minute virus definitions.

LICENSING ALL YOUR WORKSTATIONS AND SERVERS

The AVG Network Edition is licensed according to the total number of workstations and file servers combined, including:

- All workstations on the network
- Workstations that are not running AVG but are connected to a file server that is using the AVG File Server Edition
- Workstations that are not on the network (e.g., remote offices) but have AVG installed on them
- Workstations that are connected to the network only part-time (e.g., notebook computer)

Configurations of 2, 5, 10, 15, 20, 25, 30, 40, 50, 75, and 100 licenses are available, as are larger configurations upon request. The standard license period is 2 years (vs. 1-year license of other antivirus companies), giving you more time to work and less need to worry.

Optional AVG Managed Updates is provided for an additional fee from the date of activation through the duration of your AVG Network Edition license period.
